What you should know.

- Press and square the quilt top for best results, the quilt borders should measure the same size as the quilt's center. Check both the length and width for uniformity. Flared or pinched borders may create puckers or tucks in the finished quilt.
- Clip all thread tails on the quilt front and check for any holes or unsewn seams.
- When using white fabrics in a guilt top, clip all dark thread tails on the guilt back that could show through the white fabric on the front when quilted.
- The backing needs to be a minimum of 4" larger than the quilt top on all 4 sides. A total of 8" in length and 8" in width. The backing needs to be straight and square.
- When you provide the batting, it should be a minimum of 4" larger than the guilt top on all 4 sides, same as the backing.
- Press the quilt top and backing well and fold the quilt top, backing, and batting separately. Please do not layer or baste them together.
- If we are binding your quilt, please provide the fabric. Do not pre-cut or pre-make the binding.
- If you seam your backing, you should sew the seam far enough away from the selvage edge so that you can trim the selvage along the seam away. The selvage edges can shrink differently.
- It is suggested that if you washed the fabric for the quilt top you should also wash the backing. Please press the backing after washing.
- If we find any unsewn seams or similar problems, we will make the necessary repairs, up to 10 minutes, for \$15, without contacting you. If any repairs require more time, we will contact you before proceeding.
- There is a clean-up charge of \$15 for quilts with Minky or similar fabrics.
- Disclaimer on T-Shirt Quilts: TSQ will not guarantee the guilting results when: 1) Shirts other than cotton and cotton blend T-shirts are used (jerseys, polyester, and spandex shirts). 2) Shirts with thick rubberized vinyl decorations, 3) Shirts with thick embroidery or patches, 4) Poorly stabilized fabrics of any kind.
