

Block Style T-Shirt Quilt Class Supply List

*****Please pre-wash t-shirts and DO NOT use fabric softener. T-Shirt logo/design needs to fit in a 12.5" square. DO NOT cut t-shirt to 12.5" square prior to class**

*****Student Prerequisites: Sewing machine you are familiar with, experience using a rotary cutter & ruler, familiar with basic construction of a quilt, piecing & binding.**

Basic sewing supplies – scissors, pins, marking pen/pencil

12.5" square ruler

Rotary cutter & mat

Pressing cloth or solid piece of fabric large enough to cover 12.5" square

T-shirts – sample quilt used 12, you can use more or less

Pellon SF101 Shape-Flex Fusible Interfacing, 20" wide you will need approx. ½ yard per shirt, 60" wide you will need approx. ½ yard for every 3-4 shirts

***Session 1: prepare & cut t-shirts, discuss quilt layout & yardage needed**

***Session #2: sewing quilt top**

**** If you prefer to cut 15.5" blocks you will need to use a 15.5" square ruler & increase the amount of pellon needed to stabilize t-shirt**
