

# Have your Cake and Eat it Too Sew Day Supply List

Supplies:

- Sewing machine you are familiar with
- basic sewing supplies; coordinating thread, seam ripper, pins/wonder clips, marking pen/pencil, scissors, etc.
- mat, ruler, rotary cutter

\*\*\*Pick the quilt you would like to make and be sure to do the prep work prior to the class.

Samples are hanging at Top Shelf or go online to see each of the different Villa Rosa Designs patterns being offered and choose the one (or two) you would like to make. One free pattern is included and will be given to you on the day of the event. If you like TSQ's samples, there are a limited number of kits available for Darcey, Ascot and Party Girl and a limited number of layer cakes available for Kristin.

## **Darcey Quilt – @42" x 54"**

- (12) different 10" squares
- Background – 1 ½ yards
- Binding - 1/2 yard

*Prep work:*

\*Cut the (12) 10" squares in half to make (24) 5" x 10" rectangles (for directional fabric, be sure the height is 5" and the length is 10")

\*From the background: cut (3) 5" x WOF strips and sub cut into (24) 5" squares; cut another four or five 5" x WOF strips and set aside for the lattice

## **Kristin Quilt - @54" x 70"**

- (40) 10" squares
- Lattice – 3/4 yard
- Binding – 5/8 yard

*Prep work:*

\*Separate the 10" squares into (20) dark squares and (20) light squares, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (20) light squares

\*From the Lattice: cut (8) 3" x WOF strips, sew them together in sets to get (4) 3" x @87" strips

Additional supplies: 9 ½" or larger square up ruler

## **Ascot Quilt - @57" x 67"**

- (42) 10" squares
- Accent – 3/8 yard

-Binding – 5/8 yard

*Prep work:*

\*Cut each 10" square into (1) 4" x 10" and (1) 6" x 10" rectangle

\*Cut Accent into a 10" x WOF strip and sub cut into (42) 1" x 10" strips

### **Party Girl Quilt - @72" x 90"**

-(40) 10" squares

-Background – 3 yards or (40) pre-cut pack (solid) 10" squares

-Binding – 3/4 yard

*Prep work:*

\*If your background is yardage, cut it into (10) 10" x WOF strips and sub cut each strip into (4) 10" squares giving you a total of (40) squares

\*Place each of your Fabric Squares right sides together with a Background Square and cut diagonally once. These triangles are now ready to sew.

OR

\*Take your (40) Fabric squares and draw a line diagonally on the wrong side and you will be ready to sew ¼" from your line.

Additional supplies: 9 ½" or larger square up ruler
