Early Migration Pattern from Cut Loose Press (CLPDHE027)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

1/3 yard solid black

1 light fat quarter for geese background

1/4 yard blue print for outer border

1/4 yard black print for binding

(8) 2 ½" strips of assorted colors

27" x 47" backing

Cutting Instructions to be done before class

2 1/2" strips

Cut (8) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

Cut (8) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

Light Fat Quarter

Cut (5) 2 3/4" x Width of Fat Quarter strips. Sub-cut

(16) 2 3/4" for flying geese units

Black Fabric

Cut (1) 5 3/4" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut

(4) 5 ³/₄" squares for flying geese units

Cut (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for inner border; (You may wait to cut these)

sub-cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces

Blue Print (You may wait to cut these)

Cut (3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for outer border:

Sub-cut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces

Binding Fabric: (You may wait to cut these)

Cut (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips

SEWING SUPPLIES

Sewing Machine (Don't forget power cable)

Choice of 1/4" foot or guide for piecing

New needle in sewing machine

Rotary Cutter with new blade

Your Choice of pins or magic clips you use when piecing.

Rotary cutting mat
