Supplies:

-Sewing machine, you are familiar with

-basic sewing supplies, coordinating thread, seam ripper, pins/wonder clips, marking pen/pencil, scissors, etc.

-mat, rotary cutter, ruler

\*\*\*Pick the project(s) you would like to make and be sure to do the prep work prior to the class. Samples are hanging at Top Shelf Quilts. Everyone will receive one free Villa Rosa pattern and will receive it on the day of the event. If you choose the Chips and Dip pattern, there will be an additional \$5.00 charge.

**Chips and Dip – Placemats 12 ½” x 18 ½” Runner 12 ½” x 36 ½”**

**Fabric Requirements:**

Placemats (6)	Runner	Placemats & Runner
1/3 yd of 6 different fabrics	1/8 yd of 6 different fabrics	3/8 yd of 6 different fabrics
½ yd Accent	3/8 yd Accent	5/8 yd Accent
¾ yd Binding	¼ yd Binding	7/8 yd Accent

**A Jelly Roll can be used instead of yardage – see below**

Placemats (6)	Runner	Placemats & Runner
18 different 2 ½” strips	6 different 2 ½” strips	24 different 2 ½” strips
½ yd Accent	3/8 yd Accent	5/8 yd Accent
¾ yd Binding	¼ yd Binding	7/8 yd Accent

**Pre-Class Work – Cut Accent Fabric**

Placemats	Runner	Placemats & Runner
18 (4 ½”) squares	9 (4 ½”) squares	27 (4 ½”) squares

**Additional supplies -----ruler 4 ½ X 18 ½” or larger**

**Gemini - 52” x 65”**

1 jelly roll or (20) 2 ½” strips

2 yards – background

5/8 yard – binding

(over)

### **Gemini Pre-Class Work**

-Background Fabric – Cut (3) 3” strips and sub cut into (40) 3” squares

    Cut (8) 7” strips and sub cut into (40) 2 ½” x 7” rectangles and (40) 5” x 7” rectangles

-From each 2 ½” strip – Cut (4) 2 ½” x 7” rectangles and (4) 2 ½” x 3” rectangles

### **Pinked – 46” x 56”**

1 jelly roll or (28) 2 ½” strips

½ yard Accent Fabric

### **Pre-Class Work – Cut Accent Fabric**

-Cut 7 – 8 ½” x 9 ¼” rectangles

### **Voyager – 54” x 68”**

1 jelly roll or (40) 2 ½” strips

¾ yard - center squares

5/8 yard - binding

### **Pre-Class Work**

-Center squares – cut (3) 6” strips and sub cut into (20) 6” squares

-Sew pairs of 2 ½” strips together (1 light and 1 dark) to make 20 different strip sets

    Sub cut each set into (4) 4 ½” x 10” rectangles
